The Delhi Biodiversity Council (DBC) of Government of NCT of Delhi will be celebrating International Day of Biodiversity on May 22 of this year. With the aim to generate public awareness on the importance of conservation, management, and enhancement of city biodiversity for securing a better quality of living for Delhiites, the DBC is organizing a video essay competition. The competition is open to all Indians and the entries will be considered in Hindi and English. Prizes will be given out in three categories :

Students in class 8 to 12 (school)	3 prizes (1 winner + 2 runner-ups) + other notable entries would receive Certificate of Recognition
Undergraduate students (current students)	3 prizes (1 winner + 2 runner-ups) + other notable entries would receive Certificate of Recognition

### Rules of the competition:

1. All entries should be original creations and must illustrate and reflect the mentioned theme.
2. The entry is free, and is open to all Indian nationals falling under the above-mentioned categories.
3. Only one entry per individual shall be considered.
4. Each video must be limited to 3 minutes. Opening and/or closing credits are not required.
5. Ensure that all content in your video essay (including footage, music, images, props, etc.) is your own. If you include any copyrighted or trademarked content, you must be able to provide written permission for its use. Entries containing any unauthorized content will be disqualified.
6. The entries should preferably be in .mp4 format.

- The winning and selected entries would be published by DBC on its social media accounts and hosted on the Department of Forests & Wildlife GNCT of Delhi' website.
- Prize details will be announced in due course of time.
