Terms & Condition:

1. Permission for felling/transplanting the trees is granted at your risk and without prejudice to the claim(s) of any other person/s who may be having any right(s) over the land or the trees.
2. Only the trees marked for felling/transplanting shall be cut. The trees meant for saving will not be disturbed.
3. Felling/transplant of trees shall be completed within 30 days of issue of this letter.
4. Material produced from trees shall not be disposed without permission of the Tree Officer.

5. Progress report of cutting & transportation shall be submitted through inspection Officer concerned along with complete details of tree. Sh. Balbir Singh, DRO of this division is being deputed for the monitoring of the above work. You are requested to intimate this office at least 3 days in advance before starting the felling/transplant of said trees.
6. Wood obtained after felling/transplanting of the trees is to be sent necessarily and handed over to the MCD public crematoria and dated receipt may be submitted to this office within a month for record.
7. The applicant is required to deposit a security amount of Rs. 28,000/- per tree felled/transplant plus admin cost as applicable.
8. The compensatory plantations of five times the no of trees permitted for felling/transplant shall be planted at Bella farm, Delhi. Indigenous trees/saplings i.e. 180 should be completed by the applicant within 9 months from the date of issue of this order, 50% of the security amount i.e. Rs. 14,000/- per tree will be refunded if the applicant carries out compensatory plantations in the stipulated period and successfully maintains the plantations for 05 (five) years.
9. The Compensatory Plantations of five times the no. of trees permitted for felling/transplant i.e. 180 will be done by the Department of Forests and Wildlife for which 50% of the balance security deposit i.e Rs 14,000/- per tree will be utilized.
10. In the event of failure on the part of the permit holder to replant the trees as indicated at serial number 8 above, the Tree Officer shall himself arrange to replant trees and recover the cost thereof from the permit holder by way of adjustment against the security deposit made by the permission holder or failing that, by recovery as arrears of land revenue and take suitable action as per DPTA, 1994.
